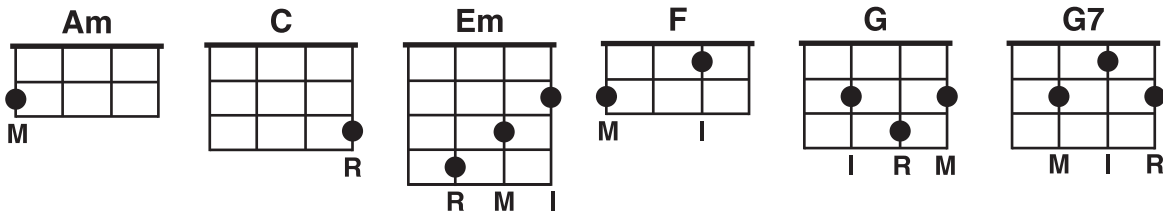


Jolly Old St. Nicholas — Emily Huntington Miller (1865)
