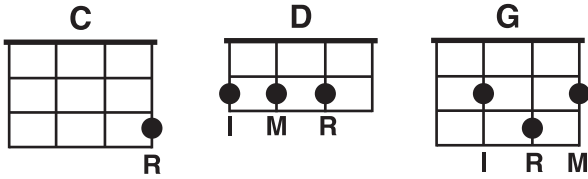


Can't You Hear Me Calling -- Bill Monroe (1950)
